

FLUORIDE SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS
OTISCO LAKE WATER TREATMENT PLANT
TOWN OF MARCELLUS

OCWA has recently completed a full-scale replacement to the Fluoride system at the Otisco Lake Water Treatment Plant. In coordination with the Onondaga County Health Department, OCWA's plant staff installed a temporary fluoride feed system to allow uninterrupted service while the contractor completed the project. Originally constructed in 1984 and last rehabilitated in 1999, the new system was produced using grant funding from the New York State Department of Health, Division of Family Health.

The improvements included new storage and feed equipment, piping, HVAC upgrades, new safety systems, state-of-the-art controls and online fluoride monitoring to further improve our ability to precisely feed the Health Department recommended dosage.
