

SKYVIEW TANKS REPLACEMENT
420 Skyview Terrace, Camillus, NY

The Skyview water system in Camillus is served by two welded-steel water storage tanks at 420 Skyview Terrace. One tank can provide up to 2 million gallons (2.0 MG) of water storage while the other tank can provide up to a half million gallons (0.5MG) of water storage. The welded steel tanks have served the Camillus area for over 55 years and are in need of replacement. OCWA is now starting a project to replace these water storage tanks.

The work will generally consist of constructing a new 1,500,000 gallon (1.5 MG) concrete water storage tank and appurtenances, demolishing the existing tanks, and completing any site restoration needed. The slightly smaller storage capacity will help to improve water quality in the service area and better balance OCWA's operations in the Camillus area.

We will keep the 0.5 MG tank in service while the 2.0 MG tank is demolished and a new tank constructed. If required during construction, we can make use of our other water storage tanks in the service area by select operation of distribution system valves. There should be no disruption of water services to the areas served as a result of the work on this project.

The work on the tank is anticipated to begin in early April, weather permitting, and will take approximately one year to complete. Work will predominantly occur during normal construction hours.
