

FARRELL PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS
4170 Route 31, Town of Clay

Onondaga County Water Authority (OCWA) is constantly upgrading and maintaining the water facilities as part of their capital improvement projects.

One of the projects to begin in 2024 is the Farrell Pump Station Improvements project. The Farrell Pumping Station was originally constructed in 1964 and included four 18mgd pumps. The pump station was designed to accommodate six pumps. This project includes the addition of two new 18mgd pumps, surge/vacuum relief, and various other HVAC and mechanical system updates. The addition of two additional pumps will increase the capacity of this pumping station, offering redundancy for OCWA to supply potential new industrial customers in the area. The surge/vacuum relief system is an added protective measure that will protect the pumping station and transmission mains from surge pressures in the event of an unscheduled shutdown.



The work is scheduled to begin in February of 2024 and will continue through the summer of 2025.
