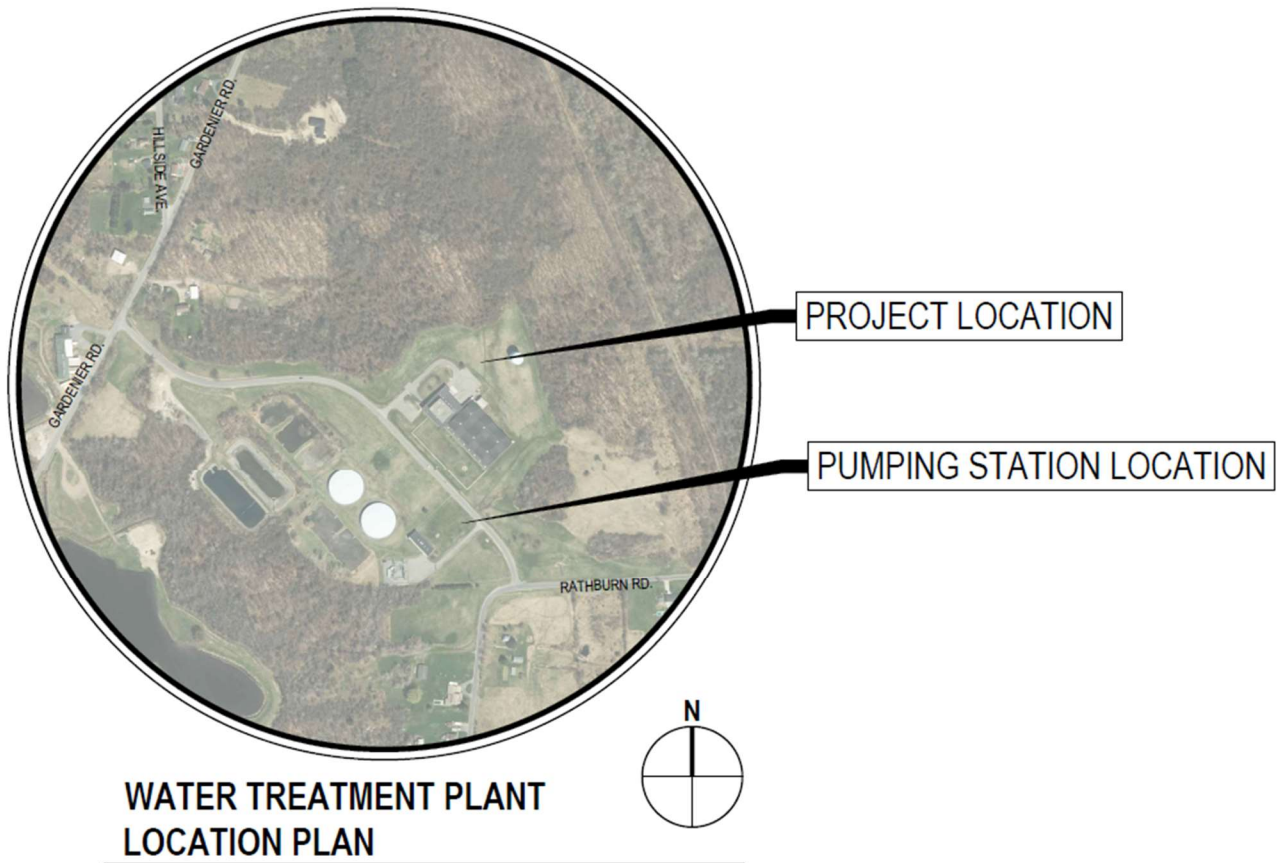


**TUG HILL PUMP STATION**  
**1633 Rathburn Road, Town of Oswego**  
**January 2024**

Onondaga County Water Authority (OCWA) is constantly upgrading and maintaining the water facilities as part of their capital improvement projects.

One of the projects to begin in 2024 is the Tug Hill Pump Station project. The Tug Hill booster pumps are currently housed within OCWA's clearwater pump station. These pumps currently serve areas of Oswego, Hannibal, Sterling, and Minetto. The current pumps have required increased maintenance efforts and their location in the clear water building does not allow for the installation of another pump.

This project will include the building of a new structure adjacent to the clear water pumping station. The new pumping station will house two new 1.5mgd pumps (the current pumps are around 1mgd each) with space for a third pump to accommodate future growth.



The work is scheduled to begin in spring of 2024 and will continue through the spring/early summer of 2025.
