



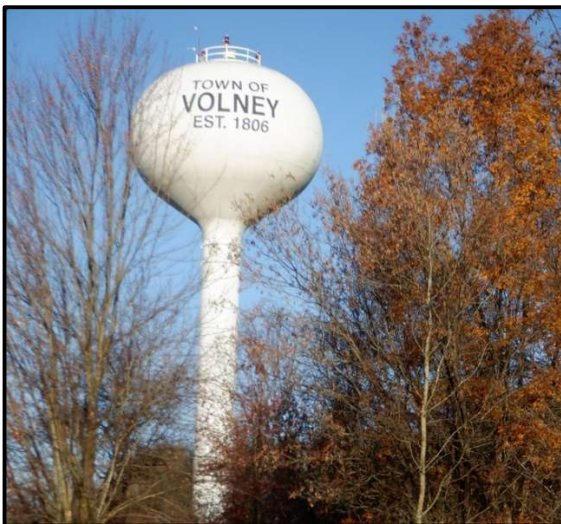
VOLNEY AIRPORT AND SENECA HILL TANK
REHABILITATION
TOWN OF VOLNEY
February 2024

This summer, OCWA will be performing maintenance work on the Volney Airport and Volney Seneca elevated tanks. The Volney Airport tank (built in 2005) is on Howard Road, east of County Route 176 in the Town of Volney. The Volney Seneca Hill tank (built in 1998) is on Manor Drive, off of County Route 45 in the Town of Volney.

Paint systems on our water tanks typically last 20 years or so and recent inspections highlighted opportunities to rehabilitate and re-establish protection of the steel components. While these tank painting projects are being completed, we will also conduct other maintenance and repair items to improve the safety and security of these tanks.

A company that specializes in water tank maintenance will be performing the work. The work involves removing the old paint first (interior and exterior). During this process, which is done through a combination of abrasive blasting using air compressors, power washers and hand tools the tank work area will be enclosed in a containment system. This containment system allows for easy collection of the old paint and provides the best environment for the application of the new paint. This work is scheduled to start in the spring of 2024 and be completed by fall of 2024.

We do not anticipate any interruptions in your water service during this work.
